


## Adding Frequently Used Resource Library Items to the Toolbar

If you are doing a unit on 3D shapes, for example, you might want 3D shapes available at a click, without searching. In the *Authoring Profile*, you can add objects you use frequently from the resource browser to your toolbar. Those objects will remain in your toolbar until you remove them.

1. Bring the object you use frequently onto a flipchart page.
